Before your party:

1. Test your tech! You will receive the YouTube link to the luncheon program on Monday, August 24th via email from Krissy Vaio. Try your link out on your TV or screen. Need tech tips? Check out our tech videos on wfco.org/hosttips

2. Explore your kit! You have lots of info that will help make your party a success. Set out your WFCO materials in a place where your guests can access them.

3. Set up your viewing area – can everyone see the program? Can everyone hear? The perfect setting will set you up for the perfect party!

During your party:

1. Use the nametags and sharpie in your kit to help your guests meet each other.

2. Spread the LOVE on social media! Share your photos, your favorite quotes, and your inspirational moments – don't forget to tag The Foundation and use our luncheon hashtag #LOVEWFCO, We're on Facebook – The Women's Foundation of Colorado, on Instagram and Twitter - @WFColorado

3. Fundraise! Twice during the program, you will hear our host, Karen Leigh from CBS4 Denver, ask guests to fill out their giving envelope or make a donation online, this is your cue to pass out the envelopes and pens. If you have a spare laptop, iPad, or tablet, you can set up the online giving page for your guests, just go to wfco.org/give

4. After the program collect your guest's giving envelopes and place them in the large white, self-addressed and stamped envelope included in your kit, and mail them back to WFCO.

5. Share the LOVE – small gifts for your guests are included in your kit – postcards, packs of WFCO branded playing cards and bracelets. The necklace is our thank you to you! All jewelry generously donated by Bead for Life/Street Business School.

6. Say thanks! We've included thank you cards in your kit so you can send notes to your guests.
