

TOGETHER Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What is TOGETHER?

A: TOGETHER is a non-partisan, non-political public event at Pepsi Center that will celebrate The Women's Foundation of Colorado's 30 years as a leader in advancing and accelerating economic opportunities for Colorado women and their families.

Q: When is the event?

A: TOGETHER is Tuesday, July 25, 2017, at 5:30 p.m. MDT at Pepsi Center in Denver, CO.

Q: Is this a political event?

A: No. TOGETHER is a celebration of The Women's Foundation of Colorado's 30th Anniversary. It is non-partisan and non-political. Protestors are not allowed on Pepsi Center property and no posters will be allowed inside Pepsi Center.

Q: Is this Mrs. Obama's first appearance in Colorado since leaving the White House?

A: As far as we know, this is her first public appearance in Colorado.

Q: Does this event take the place of The Foundation's Annual Luncheon?

A: No, TOGETHER is a special event to celebrate our 30th Anniversary. The Women's Foundation of Colorado has held an Annual Luncheon for almost 30 years and we will continue to hold our Annual Luncheon. We are thrilled that this year's speaker is Academy Award winning actress Octavia Spencer. You can purchase tickets [on our website](#) for the September 28 event.

Q: Are cameras/cell phones allowed at the event?

A: While ticket holders are allowed to have their cell phones at Pepsi Center, no pictures, audio, or video recording are permitted.

Q: Will the audience be able to ask questions?

A: No. The event features a live, one-hour conversation between Mrs. Obama and Lauren Casteel, the president and CEO of The Women's Foundation.

Q: What else does the program feature in addition to the interview with Mrs. Obama?

A: Before the interview with Mrs. Obama, there will be entertainment, including music, inspirational speakers, and videos.

Q: When do tickets go on sale?

A: Tickets go on sale at 8 a.m. MDT on Monday, May 15, through www.AltitudeTickets.com.

Q: Are media allowed?

A: The event is closed to the media. However, members of the media can purchase tickets, just as any community member can. No recording is permitted.

Q: How much are tickets?

A: Tickets start at \$54.50 (additional fees may apply). Almost half of the tickets are priced \$100 or less.

Q: Is the event open to children?

A: As with most Pepsi Center events, guests three years of age and older are required to have a ticket. Guests under the age of three years may sit in a ticketed guest's lap.

Q: Is the event open to men?

A: Absolutely! Men are an essential part of The Women's Foundation of Colorado and our goal to advance women's economic security. We have several male staff and board members as well as many donors.

Q: How do I get more involved with WFCO?

Q: Is my ticket tax deductible?
