Throughout her career, Ms. Tobey has held a number of leadership positions for Space Systems Company. In the role of Director of Program, Subcontract and Product Management, she was responsible for integrating strategic teaming, product sourcing and procurement compliance across the Space System Company. She has held positions as Chief Systems Engineer on several large national security space programs and proposals.

Ms. Tobey graduated from the University of Colorado-Boulder with a Bachelor of Science degree in Chemical Engineering and a Master of Engineering degree in Engineering Management. Ms. Tobey serves as the Lockheed Martin University Executive for CU Boulder. She is co-chair of the Advisory Board for BOLD Center (Broadening Opportunities for Leadership Diversity), the inclusive excellence program for the CU College of Engineering. Ms. Tobey is the co-chair of the Space Systems Diversity Council and is also the Executive Sponsor for WIN (Women's Intrinsic Network) a Lockheed Martin employee resource group. She is a leader in STEM education and was the Women's Vision Foundation's (now The Leadership Investment™) 2012 Woman of the Year.
